She has held the following offices: official at the Federal Ministry of Europe, Integration and Foreign Affairs (BMEIA) (1984); official in the Department of International Organizations of BMEIA (1986-1987); Permanent Representative at the United Nations in New York (1987-1990); official in the Department of International Organizations of BMEIA (1990-1993); counsellor of the embassy in Bonn (1993-1997); official at the Department of Eastern Europe and the Western Balkans at BMEIA and deputy embassy representative for Caucasus and Central Asia (2004-2006); director of the Unit for Latin America and the Caribbean, and deputy director at the Department of America in Bethlehem (2009-2014); ambassador to Algeria (since 2017).
