Her Excellency Ms. Majlinda Frangaj was born on 5 July 1972.

She graduated in political sciences, specializing in international relations (University of Perugia). She was subsequently awarded a master's degree in international human rights protection (La Sapienza University of Rome) and a master's degree in Community affairs and innovation policy, specializing in international cooperation (European Institute for Training and Orientation, Rome). She is a lecturer in comparative law of religions, as well as in Islamic and African Law, at the University of Perugia Faculty of Political Sciences.

She has held the following roles: journalist and producer in the programming department, TV Klan (2000 - 2005); service in various positions, Ministry of Foreign Affairs (2007 - 2010); first Secretary and Consul (2010 - 2012); Minister Counsellor and Consul (2012 - 2014); Minister Plenipotentiary and Chargé d'Affaires *ad interim* (2014 - 2015); Minister Plenipotentiary (2015 - 2017); and Minister Plenipotentiary and Chargé d'Affaires *ad interim* (2017 - 2023) of the Embassy of Albania to the Holy See.
