Academic formation: degree in sciences and letters, from the San Miguel Salesian Institute in Tegucigalpa; doctorate in medicine and surgery, with subsequent specialization in digestive surgery; General Hospital San Pablo, Barcelona; various specialist courses in Spain, Japan, Chile, Cuba, the United Kingdom and Costa Rica.

He has held the following offices: deputy Health Minister; regional health director; head of the Department of Surgery at *Leonardo Martínez* Hospital; head of the emergency department at *Mario Catarino Rivas* Hospital; head of surgery at *Mario Catarino Rivas* Hospital; deputy of the National Congress; chair of the Commission against Drug Trafficking.
