HIS HOLINESS POPE FRANCIS WAS DEEPLY SADDENED TO LEARN OF THE HORRIFIC ATTACK AT SAINT FRANCIS CHURCH IN OWO, AND HE ASSURES YOU AND ALL THOSE AFFECTED BY THIS ACT OF UNSPEAKABLE VIOLENCE OF HIS SPIRITUAL CLOSENESS.
