Press Conference of 19 June 2023

On **Monday 19 June 2023**, at **11.00**, in the Holy See Press Office, **Saint Pius X Hall, Via dell'Ospedale 1**, a press conference will be held entitled "*Sublimitas et miseria hominis – Greatness and misery of man*", on the occasion of the four-hundredth anniversary of the birth of the philosopher, mathematician and scientist Blaise Pascal, who was born on 19 June 1623 in Clermond-Ferrand and died in Paris on 19 August 1662.

The speakers will be:

- His Eminence Cardinal José Tolentino de Mendonça, prefect of the Dicastery for Culture and Education;
- Dr. François-Xavier Adam, director of the *Institut Français Centre Saint Louis*.

Some of Blaise Pascal's works, belonging to the collection of the Apostolic Library, will be exhibited for the occasion, on 19 June, from 9.00 to 10.00. Press Conference of 20 June 2023

On Tuesday 20 June 2023, at 14.30, in the Holy See Press Office, Saint Pius X Hall, Via dell'Ospedale 1, a press conference will be held to present the *Instrumentum Laboris* and Methodology of the first session of the 16th Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops on the theme: "For a synodal Church: communion, participation, mission" (4 to 29 October 2023).
