At 18.15 this afternoon, at Luxembourg-Findel International Airport, the farewell ceremony concluding the visit to Luxembourg took place.

Upon arrival, the Pope was welcomed by the Grand Duke and Grand Duchess of Luxembourg and the Prime Minister in VIP Lounge, and together they proceeded to the *Salon Bourlingster* for a brief discussion.

After the greetings of the respective delegations, Pope Francis boarded a Luxair B737, and at 18.38 he departed for Brussels.

The aircraft carrying the Holy Father landed at Melsbroek Air Base at 19.06.

Telegram to the Grand Duke of Luxembourg

Immediately after his departure from Luxembourg-Findel International Airport, the Holy Father sent the following telegram to Grand Duke Henri of Luxembourg:
