## PURPOSE

The *Studium*, heir to the historic *Practical School* established in the Dicastery since 1951, is now part of the Faculty of Canon Law of the Pontifical Urbaniana University, which awards the *Diploma in Magisterium and Canon Law of Consecrated Life*.

Aims to offer courses of qualified formation in theology and law of consecrated life, enhancing the practice and experience of the Dicastery.

## DESTINATORS

The *Studium* is addressed to:

- to those entrusted with governance responsibilities (general and provincial secretaries; procurators; superiors);
- to Episcopal Vicars and/or Delegates for Consecrated Life;
- to those responsible for formation;
- to those responsible for Formation Planning in diocesan seminaries and international colleges;
- to presbyters with a role in animating and accompanying Consecrated Life;
- to those consecrated persons who wish to take care of their ongoing formation;
- to those who have a research interest in regard to the Magisterium and Canonical Norms concerning the forms of Consecrated Life in the Church.

## STRUCTURE OF THE STUDIUM

### AREAS

It is divided into two complementary Areas:

**Interdisciplinary** (Wednesday)

**Canonical Norms** (Tuesday).

### DURATION

Biennial cyclic course.

### METHOD

The *Studium* provides lectures, tutorials, examinations of individual disciplines.

### DIPLOMA

In order to graduate, in addition to passing the examinations of the Disciplines of the Interdisciplinary Area and attending the Canonical Norms for the total number of hours stipulated in the *Studium* regulations, the student is required to prepare a final paper, under the direction of a Lecturer.
